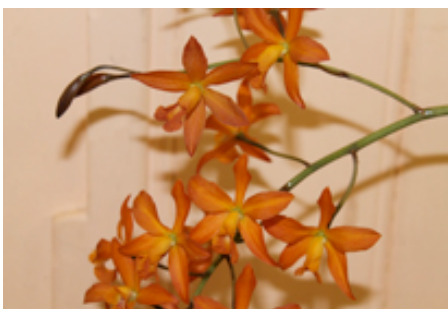


## **NEWSLETTER JUNE 2013**

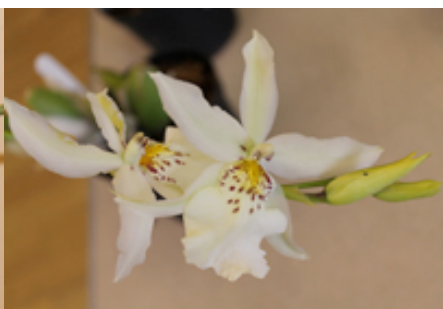

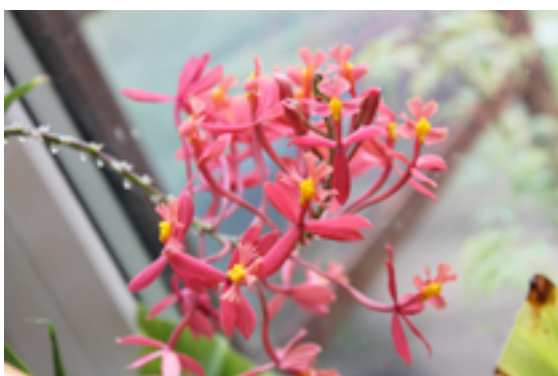
