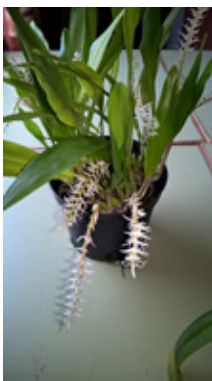




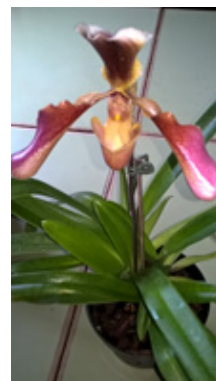
NEWSLETTER APRIL 2018

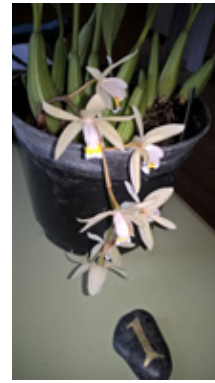
